Professor Dr. Werner Väh, vice president of Freie Universität, died on Monday after a short, serious illness. He was only 67 years old. An internationally renowned scholar, Werner Väh had held a professorial chair at the Otto Suhr Institute for Political Science

of Freie Universität Berlin since 1981. For many years, he had also been a member of the Executive Board of Freie Universität, and played a significant role in shaping the University's development. Werner Väh was a member of the International Consultative Council of "Comparative Politics" journal.
